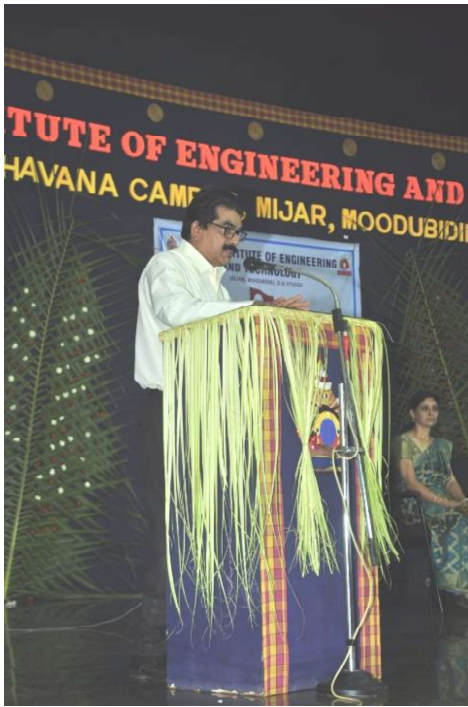


Swasthik Suvarna introduced the Chief Guest to the audience.



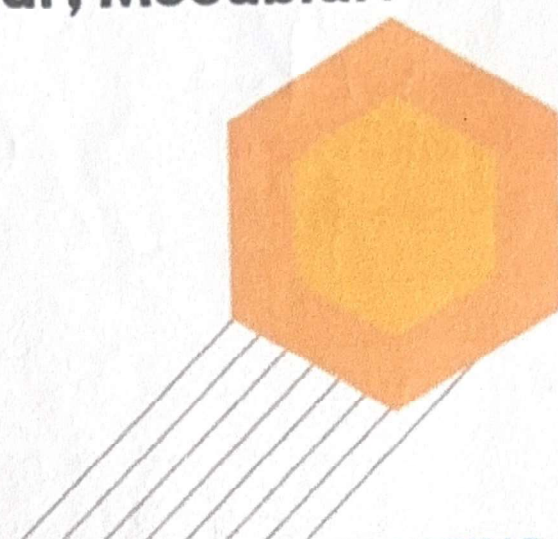

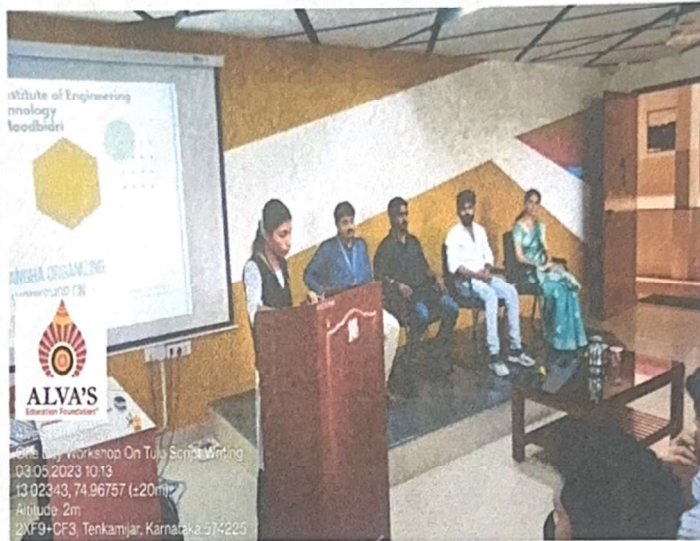




## One Day Workshop on Tulu Script Writing

On 3rd May 2023, Tulu Sangha of AIET, Mijar organized a Tulu script writing workshop training at Alvas Institute of Engineering, Mijar Moodbidri. The program aimed to introduce and train participants on the Tulu script, its evolution, and usage in different eras. The workshop was attended by around 40 students who actively participated in the training.

The program began at 10 am in the morning with welcoming of the guest speaker, Mahesh Kumar, President of Tulu Cultural Research Foundation, Mulki and the script instructor, Nischith Ramakunja, Secretary of Punname Publication, a unit of Tulu Cultural Research Foundation. The guests were offered flowers as a symbol of respect and honour. Tulu Sangha coordinators Dr. Prameela Kolake and Pramod Kumar N welcomed the guests.



The program started with an introduction to the Tulu script and its evolution. The guest speaker provided insights into the history and significance of the Tulu script in the Tulu culture. The participants were informed about the various stages of development of the Tulu script and how it evolved into the present form. The

usage of the script in different eras was also discussed in detail.



## Tulu Sangha 2022

Tulu script is an ancient writing system used to write the Tulu language, which is primarily spoken in the South Indian states of Karnataka and Kerala. The script has evolved over time, and its history dates back to the 14th century. The Tulu script is unique in its design and has several characteristics that distinguish it from other Indian scripts. The history of the Tulu script can be traced back to the 14th century, where it was written in the old Kannada script. The old Kannada script was used to write Tulu until the 20th century when the Tulu script was standardized. The Tulu script was standardized by a group of scholars who were interested in reviving the Tulu language and culture.

The standardized Tulu script is based on the old Kannada script, but it has some unique characteristics that distinguish it from the Kannada script. The Tulu script has 19 vowels and 41 consonants. It is written from left to right, and the letters are joined together to form words. The Tulu script

The modified script was based on the Roman script and was easier to read and write than the traditional Tulu script. In the 20th century, the Tulu script was standardized, and efforts were made to promote its usage. The Tulu script is now used in newspapers, books, and other publications. The usage of the script has increased in recent years, and there is a renewed interest in promoting the Tulu language and culture.

In conclusion, the Tulu script is an ancient writing system that has undergone several changes over the years. Its evolution reflects the cultural and historical significance of the Tulu

language. The Tulu script writing workshop training provided an opportunity for participants to learn about the history and evolution of the script and gain insights into its usage in different eras.

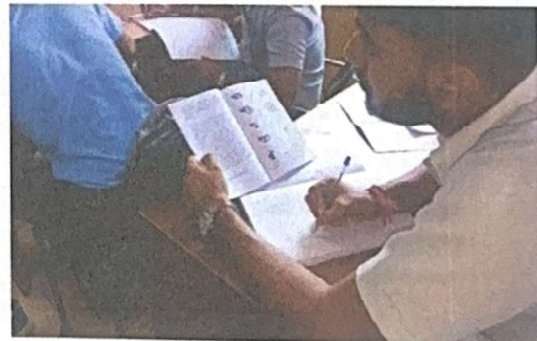
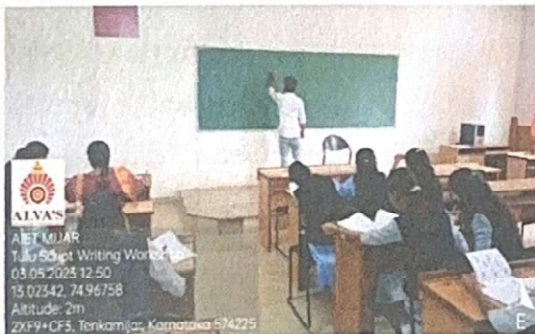


Tulu script writing through training

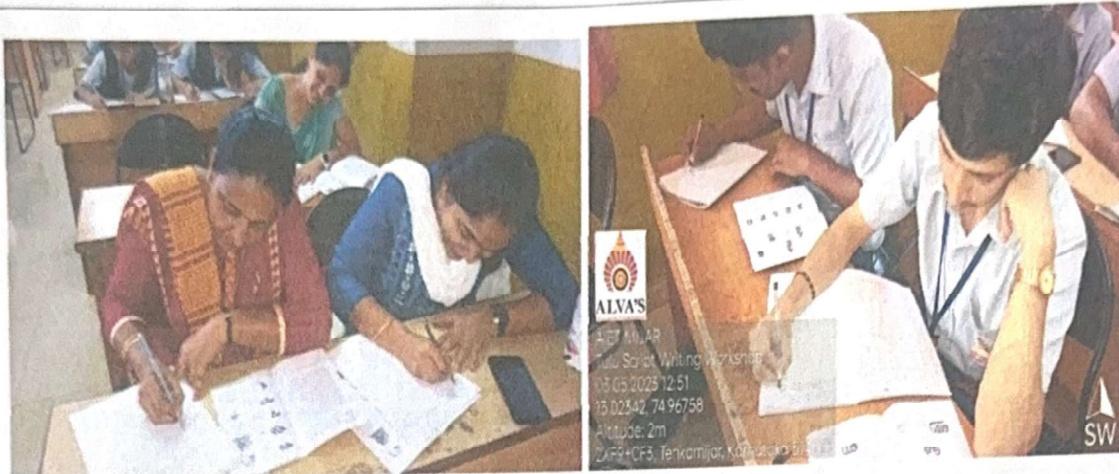
on how to improve handwriting and readability.

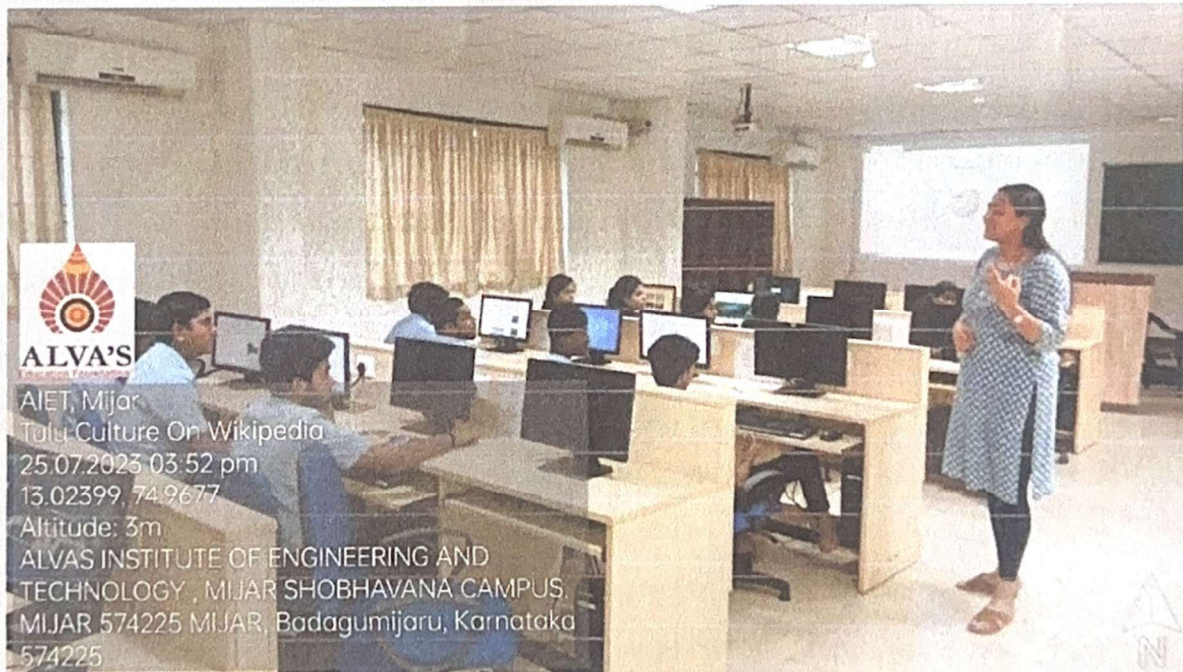


adding relevant information and citations to enhance the existing content.

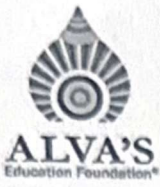

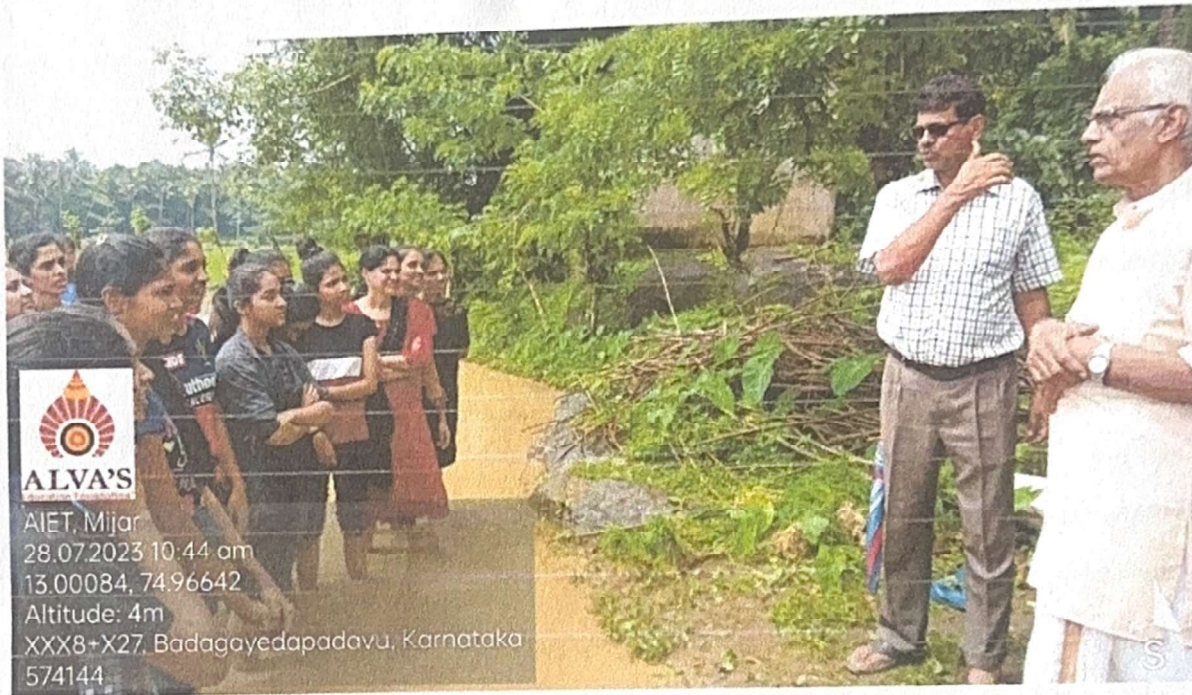
